## Parents/Guardians Code of Conduct

The Club encourages all Junior Members to act as ambassadors for the club by displaying appropriate behaviour, they welcome Parents and Guardians to observe the Junior Sessions and ask that you abide by the following:

Parents and Guardians are important role models and should support the Club and Juniors

1. Encourage good sportsmanship and publicly accepting official judgements
2. Encourage your child to learn the rules and participate within them.
3. Support your child's involvement by recognising good performance, not just results.
4. Never force a child to take part in a sport.
5. Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
6. Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding good performances by all.
7. Use correct and proper language at all times.
8. Inform the coaches promptly of any change in contact details or any other relevant information which the coach needs to know to facilitate participation, safety and welfare, honesty and communication help progression.
9. Tell the club or coach promptly of any concerns you have regarding the behaviour or welfare of others.
10. Support your child's involvement and help them enjoy their sport.
11. Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
12. Be open and receptive to advice and observations of Coaches. Our Coaches are friendly and approachable, please do not argue with them publicly, but request some personal attention at a mutually agreeable time.
